Difficulties:

Small fit issues where the upper deck fits to the lower hull near the back plate. Some vallejo piastic putty resolved the problem. The kit did not supply tow cables.



Additional Comments:

I started this kit around 2017. There were no problems with the assembly. The reason I did not give an "Accuracy" rating is because I don't know how accurate it is. I'm not a bolt and rivet counter when building any type of model. If it looks like a Panther tank, then that's good enough for me.

The finished model represents tank #745 of 7./Pz.Abt.52.Pz Regt. 39, during the pivotal 1943 Battle of Kursk. Kit provided Cartograf decals contain markings for seven different tanks. It has a nice turned aluminum barrel and photo-etch parts. I used Vallejo paints, washes, mud, and pigments to finish the model.

KIT REVIEW: EDUARD'S 1/48 Bf109F-4 PROFIPAK KIT

Difficulties:

Eduard generally makes excellent and accurate aircraft kits with some exceptions. Some kits can be too difficult for the average modeler while others have fit problems and warpage depending on the age and condition of the kit. The Bf109F-4 kit which I recently completed fits into the excellent category with nice glossly clear instructions and a lot of quality parts. Even the box art on this kit is outstanding. I have nothing negative to say about this kit other than there is a high parts count with a large number of parts that go with other kits. Also, since there are markings for six aircraft, the builder has the follow the instructions closely to insure that the correct parts are used for a specific aircraft.

Additional Comments:

The Bf-109F series was introduced in 1941 and represented a significant improvement over the earlier Bf-109E series. Being a Profipack kit, as distinguished from the simpler Weekend Build kits, the box contains a photo-etch fret in color for both the interior and exterior, masks for the canopy parts, and decal markings for six aircraft. With few exceptions, the kit fit perfectly with very little fill required. Instructions are beautifully printed and easy to follow. I chose markings for the plane marked number 14 flown by Lt. Hans-Joachim Marseille with JG27 in North Africa during 1942. Marseille was dubbed the "Star of Africa" and was the number one ace in North Africa with 158 kills to his credit. His aircraft was painted RLM 79 "Sandgelb on the upper surfaces and RLM 78 "Himmelblau" on the lower ones. Since I use Tamiya paints, I had to mix Flat Earth, Desert Yellow, and Buff in order to achieve the tan color. The rudder was painted with a red-brown primer and was adorned with 50 kill marks. The white band around the fuselage and nose and the white propeller spinner identify the aircraft as one flown in the Mediterranean Theater. Overall, this kit was a joy to build even though it took me a little longer than most single engine prop aircraft.




